



## ALTERNATIVE DAILY LANDFILL COVER/CALCULATION OF DIVERSION

Currently Missouri does not permit the use of ground/treated CRT glass for alternative daily cover in landfills. Some states do allow such use. Illinois is one. Missouri DNR also does not allow any source of alternative daily cover to be included in calculations for determining waste diversion/recycling.

The US EPA has recently issued a statement leaving the use of CRT glass for alternative daily cover to be included as a waste diversion/recycling to be a state by state determination.

MORA opposes **defining the use of CRT glass or any alternative daily cover as landfill diversion** and as such should not be considered in calculating diversion rates or recycling rates.
