4. **Kansas City** is hosting a special “Hard to Recycle Items” collection event at 1320 Truman Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. November 22nd. Participating partners include Habitat for Humanity, Salvation Army, Surplus Exchange, Ripple Glass, RevolveKC: Bicycles, Pink Hill Construction & Demolition, Avenue of Life: Mattresses, and ProShed: off-site document shredding and block Styrofoam, are partnering with City of Kansas City for a **RESCHEDULED recycling event**, November 22, 2017. In addition to this special event, we will have a truck at our regular Saturday remote collection in the Lowe’s parking lot at 133rd & State Line Rd.
5. **The Joplin Recycling Center** will hold composting demonstrations and other events on Friday and Saturday, Nov. 11-12, in honor of America Recycles Day, which is set for Tuesday, Nov. 15. From 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on both days, Joplin residents who come to the center at 1310 W. A St. can pick up a free welded-wire compost bin along with an instructional brochure and a sample bag of “SproutFaster,” an organic fertilizer made from worm "castings" or waste. Products will be available while supplies last. During those hours, Master Gardeners and Missouri Master Naturalists also will demonstrate and answer questions about recycling yard and kitchen waste into compost and the benefits of using natural or organic fertilizers. Residents also will be given instructions on making a dog waste digester from a plastic garbage can or bucket and lid. It works similar to a miniature septic system.
6. Join **Downtown Overland Park and Johnson County Recycles** for an electronic recycling and document shredding event in celebration of America Recycles Day on Wednesday, 11/15, from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Drop off and recycle any item with a cord:
  - \* Televisions (\$20 fee per item)
  - \* CRT Monitors (\$15 fee per item)
  - \* All other electronics (cell phones, digital cameras, keyboards, etc.) are FREE to drop off!Drop and shred confidential documents with PROSHRED of Kansas & Missouri!  
The drop-off point will be in the parking lot just off of Marty Street between 79th and 80th Street (near the Overland Park Farmers Market pavilion).
