Describe the programs offered by your sheltered workshop that are innovative, collaborative, and/or educational. Please include how you believe the sheltered workshop could (or *does*) benefit from being a MORA member.
2. Be sure to include in the letter:
 - Your name and affiliation with the Missouri Sheltered Workshop you represent
 - The services provided by the Missouri Sheltered Workshop
 - The geographic area served by the Missouri Sheltered Workshop
 - Your contact information including mailing and email address.

Submissions must be received on or before noon on Friday, July 14, 2017.

Recipients will be notified no later than Wednesday, July 19, 2017.

You will receive confirmation via email that your letter and support documentation has been received.
