






Raises the maximum speed limit on rural interstates and freeways of the state from 70 to 75 miles per hour.


Requires the Department of Natural Resources to implement regulations that comply with the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change Paris Agreement.




Provides that judges may assign roadside cleanup as a condition of probation.




Designates the "Trooper John N Greim Memorial Highway" on a portion of U.S. Highway 50 in Johnson County.




HJR 17 Messenger, Jeff(R)



Proposes a constitutional amendment to direct increased funding from motor vehicle registration fee adjustments for inflation to a farm to market fund, a port development fund, the state road bond fund, and the highway patrol.

Proposes a constitutional amendment to require that the conservation sales tax be renewed by voters every six years.


SB 166 Crawford, Sandy(R)




Requires a portion of sales and use tax revenue to be deposited into the State Road Fund




